Between courses, minstrels, sword-fighters, singers, dancers and presentations will amuse the assembled throng. Guests will be encouraged to wear period dress, also.

Admission will be by ticket only, at a cost of \$50 per person, and will provide a whole evening of food, activity and spectacle. Profits will go to the Glengarry Memorial Hospital Foundation, which is actively participating in promoting this event.
