**Maxville, August 25<sup>th</sup>:** Following on the astounding success of last year's endeavour, **Glengarry Place for the Arts** is pleased to announce its **2<sup>nd</sup> Medieval Feast** to be held on Saturday, October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at the Metcalfe Centre on the Maxville Fairgrounds.

The price is being held at \$50 per person but, once again, tickets must be purchased in advance. (There is a limit of 140 guests, so early reservations are recommended.) Tickets can be booked online at <http://www.glengarryplace.ca/Tickets>.

The approximately five hours of revelry begins when the "drawbridge" opens to guests at 5:30pm, with merchants and entertainers on-hand, dressed in authentic costume. The assembled throng will be seated at 6:30pm and the traditional "fayre" will be served in four "removes" (courses). Between courses, minstrels, sword-fighters, singers, dancers and presentations will amuse the revellers. Last year, most guests wore period dress and they are encouraged to do so again. (The names of several area costume rental stores are listed on the GPA website.)

In 2007, the \$1000 that was raised was donated to the **Hôpital Glengarry Memorial Hospital Foundation**. This year, proceeds will be donated to local Celtic Arts groups.
