Maxville, September 29th: Preparations continue for the 2nd **Medieval Feast** to be held by **Glengarry Place for the Arts**, on Saturday, October 18th at the Metcalfe Centre, on the Maxville Fairgrounds. With three weeks to go, final touches are being put to the program, menu and decorations.

The meal will again be served in four *Removes* (courses): first Vegetable Soup with authentic-style bread; second Chicken or Vegetable Pot Pie; third Roast Pork, with chunky applesauce and root vegetables; and finally a variety of Tarts for dessert. Nuts, fruit, bread and cheese will be on the tables before the start of the meal. Draught beer will be available in period pottery tankards, and pottery goblets will be available for the wine served with the feast.

Entertainment will take place between the Removes and will include authentic fighting, singing and dancing. Merchants will be selling traditional wares. Period dress is encouraged.

The Drawbridge opens at 5:30pm and the Festivities begin promptly at 6:30pm. Tickets are \$50 per person and must be purchased in advance. The number is limited and the deadline for ordering is Sunday, October 12th. It is intended that proceeds after expenses will be donated to local Celtic Arts groups.
