Maxville, October 30, 2009: Owing to insufficient interest in the St Andrew's Night celebration, which was due to be held this year on November 21st in Maxville, Glengarry Place for the Arts has reluctantly decided not to hold this heritage event. The GPA executive feels that 100 paying patrons are needed to make the occasion a success and, in recent years, we have not had this kind of support.

Although, all around the world, people will be observing the patron Saint of Scotland, this will not happen formally in Glengarry this year. Originally sponsored by the Glengarry Pipe Band, this event has taken place in the county since 1970.
